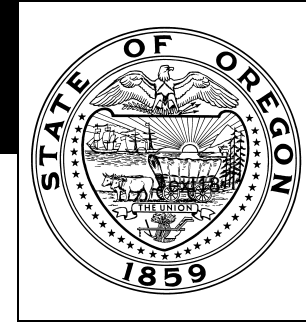

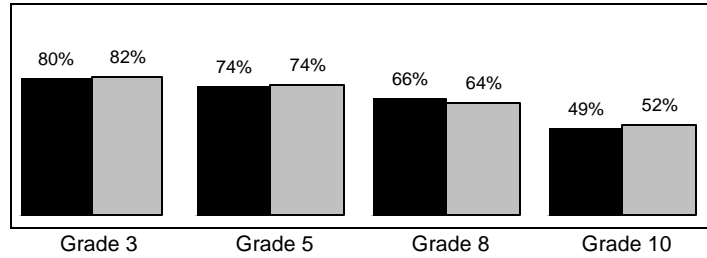

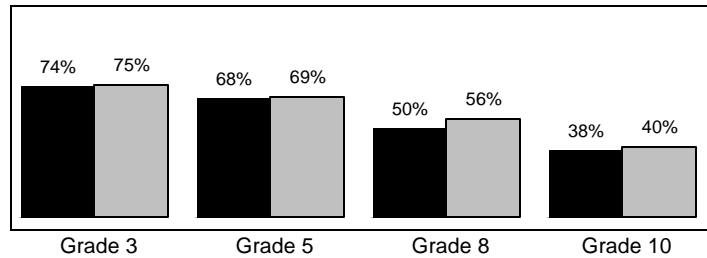

The graphs below show the percent of students who met the standards on state reading, mathematics multiple choice, writing, and mathematics problem solving tests in Spring, 2000.

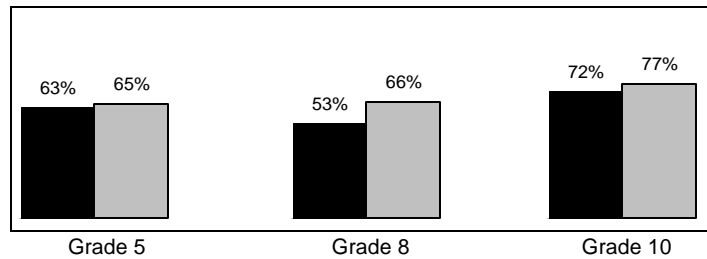
### READING



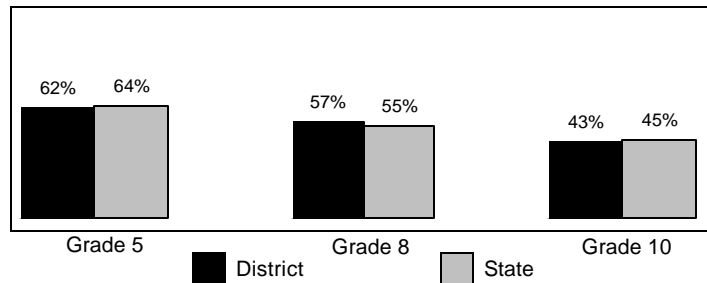
### MATHEMATICS



### WRITING



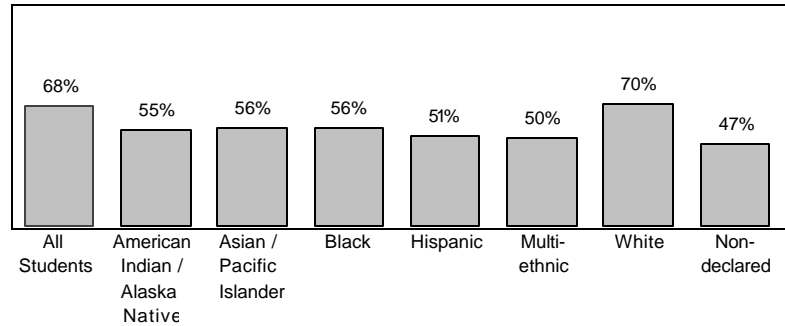
### MATHEMATICS PROBLEM SOLVING



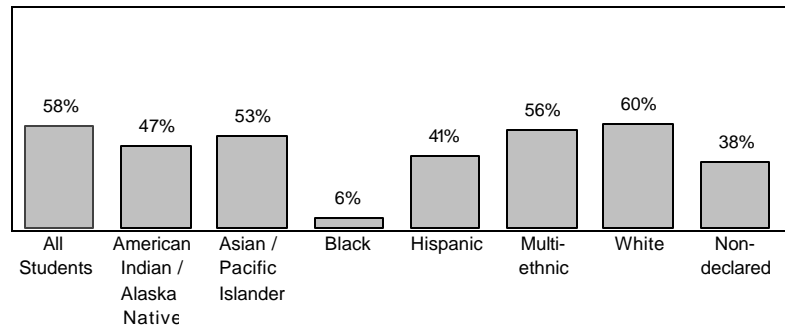
## PERCENT OF STUDENTS MEETING STANDARDS BY ETHNICITY
