- **Weighting of Science Score Reporting Categories**

The chart below shows the score reporting categories for each of the benchmark levels and the percentage of questions on a given test form that assess that category. For example, at grade 5 (Benchmark 2), 33% of the items on a test assess Physical Science, which equals about 17 items on a 50-item test.

■ **Weighting of Reading/Lit Score Reporting Categories**

The chart below shows the score reporting categories for each of the grade levels and the percentage of questions on a given test form that would be assessing that category. For example, at grade 3, 28% of the items on a test assess Vocabulary, which equals about 14 items on a 50-item test. NA indicates that skills for a particular SRC are not assessed at that grade level.
